

Classic Sea of Cortez itinerary From Nautilus Dive Adventures



Day 1 – Welcome aboard

Drop by our SeeCreatures dive centre in Cabo to get kitted up with any rental gear you might need and to take advantage of a complimentary warmup dive at Land's End. Or if you prefer, sign up for some additional Cabo diving before embarking our beautiful Gallant lady. Please be back at the dive centre by 4:30pm to board your liveaboard and depart for the Sea of Cortez. There will be a cocktail hour on the deck to watch the sunset. Enjoy a smooth overnight run continuing north.



Day 2 to 7 – Exploring southern Sea of Cortez

We'll be exploring the best of the southern Sea of Cortez including our old favourites: the wreck of the ferry Salvatierra, beautiful Suwaneef Reef teeming with life, the charming sea lions at Los Islotes, giant mantas at La Reyna, Las Animas, and Cerralvo Island. Years ago, we stopped offering trips into the Sea of Cortez because the mantas and sharks had disappeared. We are incredibly gratified that the population is rebounding, and we should see sharks, a chance of seeing mantas, as well as the more typical Sea of Cortez life.

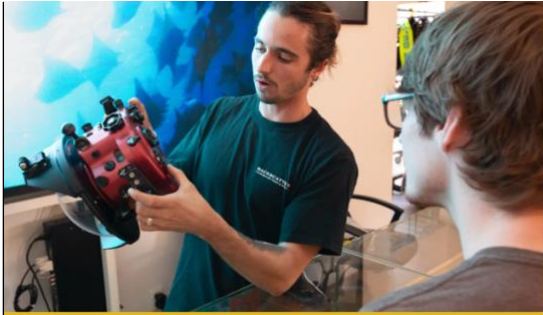


Day 8 – Always sad to say goodbye to our guests!

At 7:30pm we'll board the Nautilus Gallant Lady to depart for the Sea of Cortez.

Toast to your upcoming adventure with a delicious dinner as we make the five-hour voyage to Cabo Pulmo.



Days 2 – 6 – Swim with Mobulas

Slip into a wonderful routine of eat, sleep, mingle with mobulas, repeat.

We will have airplane support three days on this expedition to get you in the water with the biggest squadrons of mobula rays and the best chance of orcas. We will be dividing into two groups of six at a time in our high speed 32 ft support boat to get you in the water as often as possible. The more times you splash, the greater your chance of a magical encounter with mobulas. And fingers crossed, orcas...

Day 7 – Explore Cabo Pulmo

On the final day, you'll have the opportunity to dive or snorkel at Cabo Pulmo World Heritage Biosphere Reserve, home to some of the fishiest waters we've come across (over 6,000 species and counting, to be specific).

Finish the day enjoying a barbecue on the beach before we set sail for Cabo San Lucas.

Day 8 – Wave Goodbye
